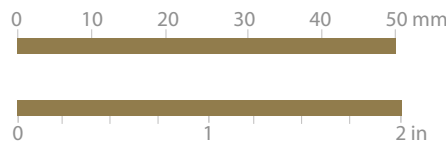


GUIDE FOR MEASURING A SALVADORI RING

NOTES

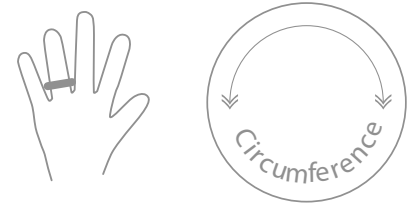
Dear customer, with the purchase of a ring we recommend that you refer to the table below for the sizes Salvadori relates to for its own measurements. Salvadori sizes correspond to Italian measurements.

CONFIRM PRINT TABLE OF MEASUREMENTS



1) Print this document on an A4 sheet and check with a ruler that the scale shown here is correct (2 cm). If it is not accurate, please check your print settings.

2) Place one ring in your possession above the circles. The circumference of these printed circles should be equal to the inner circumference of your ring. If you in doubt between two sizes, choose the larger one.

3) Or you can use a tape measure and compare the circumference measurements written in the circles at the bottom. These measures are in millimetres (Italian measurement). Using this technique, it is advisable to measure the finger towards evening in mild weather conditions. If you have marked knuckles, take the measurement with the tape directly around this point.
